Pakistan Floods – a Disaster like Never Before

The unrelenting floods in Pakistan have already affected more than 20 million people, destroyed over 720,000 homes and killed more than 1400 people. The monstrous waters have destroyed thousands of hectares of crops and shattered countless livelihoods.

The torrents have washed away homes, schools, roads, bridges and other infrastructural facilities. Deadly landslides have taken a heavy toll. Entire villages have been submerged and many towns inundated. The raging waters have displaced millions and caused death, disease and destruction everywhere. These are the deadliest floods in the history of Pakistan and this disaster is regarded as even worse than the 2005 earthquake in Pakistan. According to the United Nations, the number of people suffering from the flooding exceeds the total of those affected by the 2004 Indian Ocean tsunami, the 2005 Kashmir earthquake and the 2010 Haiti earthquake.

Call for Help

The government of Pakistan is struggling to cope with the scale of the disaster and has made a desperate appeal to the international community and the local/international NGOs to help by donating tens of millions of dollars and lend a hand in the rescue & relief operations and arrange for supplies of food and medicine. The United Nations' Secretary General, Mr. Ban Ki-moon, has appealed to the world community for \$460 million in emergency aid.
